Keith & Arthur Counties





Nebraska Extension works with cattle producers in Keith & Arthur Counties to help them improve productivity, sustainability, and profitability of their operation.

Last winter, a producer from Keith County called Livestock Systems Educator, Randy Saner. The producer only had cornstalk bales to feed to his cattle. Nebraska Extension developed rations with limited forage supplies. Nebraska Extension worked to develop rations that helped the producers pregnant cows keep in good condition and develop their calves. The producer preg checked his cows this fall and had only 8.5% open while neighbors around him had 20 and 25% open.

Programs At-A-Glance

- 61 food managers/handlers were taught "Serv Safe" food management procedures that result in improved food safety practices for over 1,500 customers throughout Keith County.
- Horticulture, Landscape and Environmental Systems: 803 calls, emails, and horticulture visits over the year - a solid quarter of the calls came from Keith/Arthur Counties.
